2	Rescue equipment:	<p>The airport has a total of 4 Oshkosh Striker mobile units, of which 3 of them are in service 24/7, and there is 1 additional unit as a backup. The capacities of these units are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • TA-01: 5,678 liters of water, 250 kilos of chemical powder and 854 liters of foam concentrate with a type B effectiveness. • TA-06: 11,356 liters of water, 250 kilos of chemical powder and 1,590 liters of foam concentrate with a type B effectiveness. • TA-07: 11,356 liters of water, 250 kilos of chemical powder and 1,590 liters of foam concentrate with a type B effectiveness. • TA-12: 11,356 liters of water, 250 kilos of chemical powder and 1,590 liters of foam concentrate with a type B effectiveness.
3	Capability for removal of disabled aircraft:	The procedure is established in the airport emergency manual.
4	Remarks:	<p>Minor and protective equipment is available. There are 10 firefighters per shift.</p>
