

**PRA/JUR/ATP****LIMITS OF LIABILITY ESTABLISHED IN THE**  
**MONTREAL CONVENTION OF 1999**  
**LE 3/38.1-IND/24/8**

The Civil Aviation Authority, through letter N°DGAC-DG-OF-0039-2025 of January 9, 2025, informs:

The International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) has notified through letter LE 3/38.1-IND/24/8 that, as of December 28, 2024, the new liability limits established in article 24 of the Montreal Convention of 1999 came into force for all States; a party to the aforementioned Convention reports the following:

*Because this Convention applies to all international transport of persons, baggage or cargo carried out in aircraft, in exchange for remuneration, as well as to free transport carried out in aircraft by an air transport company; I hereby inform you of the readjustment of the limits of liability of air carriers for damages related to the transport of passengers, baggage and cargo, which will take effect on December 28, 2024, as detailed in the following table:*
