**GEN 4.2 CHARGES FOR THE USE OF AIR NAVIGATION SERVICES**

The Civil Aviation Authority announces that, effective **immediately** and until **September 29, 2026**, the title of the table in item 4 of section 4.2.2 *Flight Protection Services* has been modified.

**4.2.2 Flight Protection Services**

1. Aircraft users or owners who are not registered as customers or who do not have a payment arrangement with COCESNA must pay for their flight at the following link: <https://www.paypal.me/COCESNA/>.
2. If you need more information, you can access the website <https://cocesna.org/home/navegacion-acna/> or the application <https://apps.cocesna.org/fycbilling/pages/fyc/fycbilling.jsp> where you can find out if you have pending flights, calculate the cost of the proposed flight, and pay through the Paypal link.
3. The Aeronautics/Civil Aviation Administration will request the respective solvency from COCESNA for the extension or revalidation of the aircraft's Certificate of Airworthiness, in the case of International General Aviation (IGA), or the Operating Certificate or Permit for commercial aviation.
4. The following rates will apply to all flights using COCESNA's Flight Protection facilities and services in the Central American FIR/UIR:

Category	Maximum Takeoff Weight (MTOW)* in Kilograms (kg)	Charges per nautical mile flown in USD (US dollars)
I	77,001 ó más	0.69
II	45,001 a 77,000	0.51
III	22,001 a 45,000	0.37
IV	5,670 a 22,000	0.24

\*Note: The Maximum Takeoff Weight (MTOW) referred to in the table above is the maximum weight certified by the aircraft manufacturer.
